Dear Congressman Pascrell:


I am writing to ask you for your immediate attention to the G-8 Summit in Northern Ireland scheduled for June 17-18, 2013. We believe that it will be a great opportunity for us to persuade Japan to do the right things pertaining to the Comfort Women issue. **We respectfully ask you to persuade President Obama to include statements about Comfort Women in his speech at the G-8 Summit.**

As you already know, some prominent Japanese politicians made controversial statements denying the Japanese government's role in operating the notorious "comfort stations" for its soldiers. The statements underscore just how important it is for the Japanese Government to acknowledge and accept its responsibility in this crime and teach their next generations to prevent this from happening ever again.
